## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS on TCM

### **Building Bridges of Integration for Traditional Chinese Medicine 2003**

**East Rutherford, New Jersey — October 9–12, 2003**

The goal of *Building Bridges for TCM 2003* is to foster improved health options and outcomes by providing a forum for the medical and health-care communities to explore all aspects of the traditional Chinese medicine system including the philosophical and theoretical underpinnings of TCM as well as the scientific research base of evidence for the full complement of modalities in the traditional Chinese medical system. Abstracts may include research on acupuncture, Chinese herbal medicine, Qigong, Tuina, and any aspect of traditional Chinese medicine.

#### **Oral Panels — Poster Sessions — Research Roundtable**

**Opening Reception:** Abstract presenting authors are invited to the reception on Oct 9.

**Publication:** All abstracts presented will be published in the Abstract/Program Book.

#### **Awards – Travel Support**

Two awards for the most outstanding abstracts presented in oral panel sessions and one for the most outstanding poster session: \$500, \$300 or \$250 cash awards toward travel reimbursement. Notifications will not be sent prior to the conference.

#### **Reduced Registration**

Investigators and research authors register prior to Sept 1 at the Student Standard rate: \$179 for 3 days; \$159 for 2 days; and \$139 for one day. Individual Standard after Sept 1.

#### **Abstract Submission Calendar**

**June 14:** Abstract Submissions must be postmarked by June 14. \$25 abstract submission fee.

**Aug 1:** Notification of abstracts for oral panels. All submitters may present at poster sessions.

**Sept 1:** Oral and poster abstract presenters must confirm their participation and be registered by Sept 1. For discounted rate, researchers must be registered by Sept 1.
